

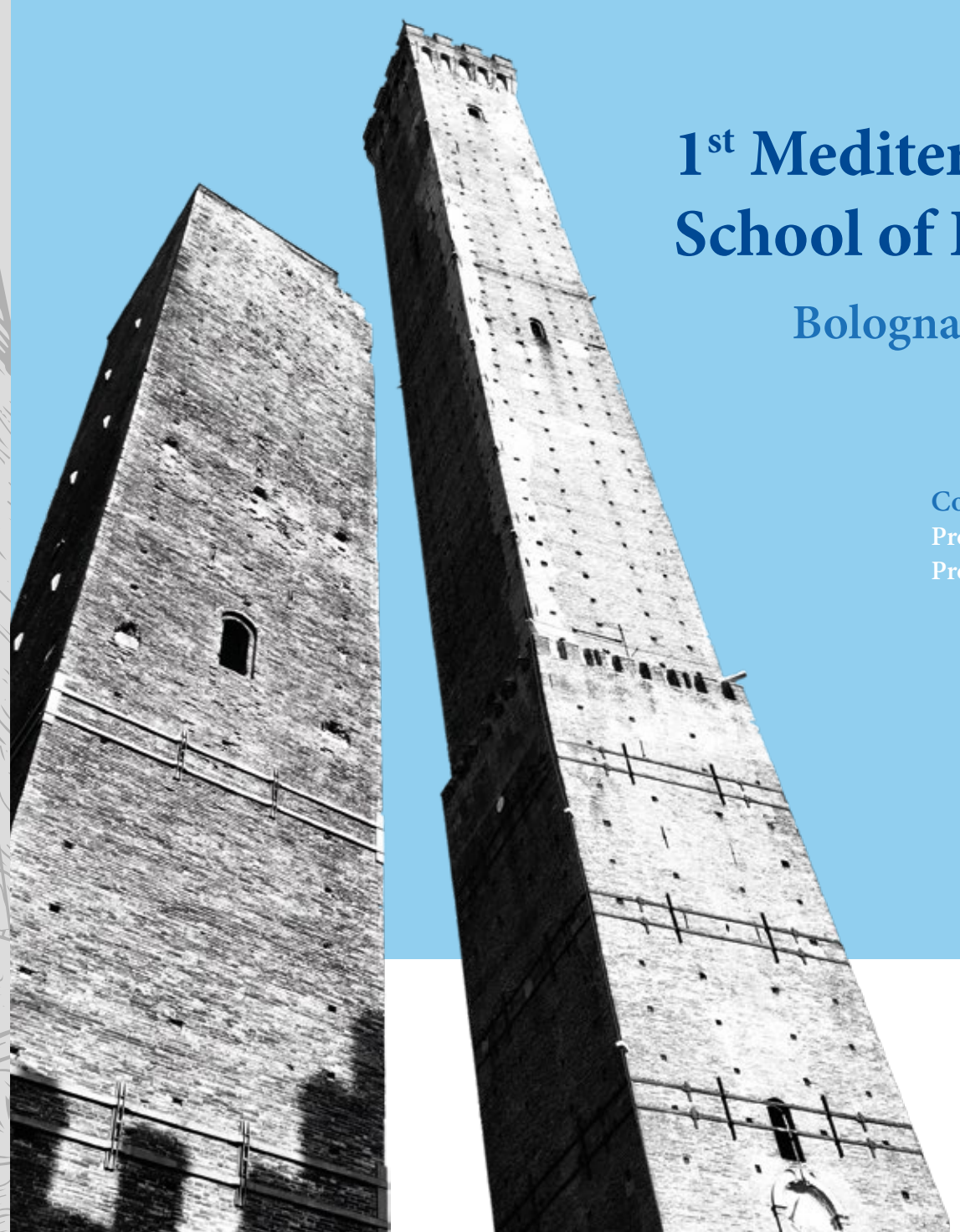

In a rapidly changing clinical practice it is important to be updated about the recent developments in the field of psychiatric treatments. This is the focus of the I Mediterranean School of Psychiatry where established experts with complementary knowledge will present and discuss the most recent and hot topics.

A number of new antipsychotics have been recently launched in the market and Prof. Serretti will present their use in both bipolar and major depressive disorders.

The traditional view of antipsychotics within schizophrenia only is now obsolete, but the many compounds available needs to be well known in order to be used in appropriate clinical pictures and to avoid mistreatment and unwanted side effects or poor efficacy.

Neuroinflammation is the emergent topic in psychiatry, Prof. Benedetti is a worldwide expert in the field and will detail the relevance of neuroinflammation in psychiatric disorders and for new treatments.

Prof. Dilbaz will focus on Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder, a largely underrecognized disorder, which needs appropriate treatments in order to avoid worsening of the disorder itself with a focus on novel treatments.

Prof. Dr. Karamustafalioglu will provide an overview on the treatment of panic disorder, which is frequently considered an easy to treat disorder but there are challenges in cases of treatment resistant panic disorder.

Finally, prof. Benedetti will describe how immune mechanisms can affect brain function and contribute to psychiatric illness as the nascent field of immunopsychiatry shows.
